Lectures and Practical Trainings

The subject consists of two lectures and three practical classes, all of which are obligatory to attend. One lecture concentrates on First Aid in basic traumatic and non-traumatic cases, the second lecture concentrates on Basic life support in adults and children.

After these Lectures three Pracitical trainings follow. First is concentrated on cases of traumatic and non traumatic origin, second concentrates on Basic Life Support in adults and third concentrates on Basic Life Support in children. The third practical training is also the Credit Practical training. All Practical trainings are situated in Simulation Center of The Faculty of Medicine.

Lectures and Practical Trainings are obligatory. We allow one absence from all five lessons.

Test in the Moodle system before practical trainings

To make the practical teaching efficient, detailed theoretical knowledge of information provided during lectures is required. Therefore you have to pass the test in the Moodle system during the week before the first practical training. The test will be concentrated only to Basic Life Support in adults and children. The test is also part of your credit testing. The test has 10 questions and to pass the test, at least 8 answers must be correct. You will have 2 attempts to pass the test.

The test will be opened before your first Practical training and you will find the test here:

Student, who does not pass the test will have the third opportunity to pass the test after the last practical class.

But the test is just one part of credit testing. At the credit practical training we will also test your ability to perform CPR (Basic Life Support and use of AED).

Credit

All students have to:

- successfully pass the test in Moodle before first practical training,
- attend at least four of five First Aid lessons,
- and prove their ability to perform CPR on the last practical training.
