### Test in the Moodle system before practical trainings

To make the teaching efficient, detailed theoretical knowledge of information provided during lectures is required, and we think, that the knowledge of Basic Life Support is of the utmost importance. Therefore you have also to pass the test in the Moodle, which is part of the credit. Test is concentrated only on **Basic Life Support**. The test must be written at least before the **third** practical training (which is the training concentrated on Basic Life Support). You will have two attempts to pass the test.

The student, who would not complete the test (successfully or unsuccessfully) before the third Practical training will be classified as **ABSENT** at one practical training.

Student who doesn't pass the test successfully will have the third attempt after the **fourth** practical training.

### Location and organisation of practical training

All practical trainings are organized in the Simulation Center of the Medical Faculty. (Main Building, opposite to the Deans office). All the study groups will be divided into two subgroups (A and B). First four practical trainings are for subgroup A and as soon as subgroup A finishes its classes then the subgroup B will follow with its four practical trainings. How your groups are divided into subgroups, you can find at the end of this letter.

### Credit

All students have to:

- successfully pass the test in Moodle **before** third practical training,
- attend at least three practical trainings (have in mind that if you do not complete the test in Moodle, you will be automatically classified as absent a tone of the practical trainings)
- and prove their ability to perform CPR (Basic Life Support and use of AED) on the last practical training.
